WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and

STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The weekly average of member bank reserves for the week ending June 27 decreased \$86 million to \$19,030 million. Estimated required reserves decreased \$65 million; and estimated excess reserves decreased \$21 million to \$585 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$171 million, compared with \$158 million the week before.

The principal changes reducing reserves were decreases of \$138 million in Federal Reserve float and \$14 million in Federal Reserve holdings of U. S. Government securities, and an increase of \$35 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$56 million in money in circulation, \$34 million in foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$27 million in "other" deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. Total Reserve Bank credit decreased \$158 million.

As of Wednesday, June 27, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$30 million higher than a week earlier and member bank borrowings were \$214 million lower.
