WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and

STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The weekly average of member bank reserves for the week ending July 4 decreased \$128 million to \$18,902 million. Estimated required reserves decreased \$9 million; and estimated excess reserves decreased \$119 million to \$473 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$170 million, compared with \$164 million the week before.

The principal changes reducing reserves were an increase of \$278 million in money in circulation, and decreases of \$138 million in Federal Reserve float and \$113 million in member bank borrowings. The principal offsetting changes were an increase of \$313 million in Federal Reserve holdings of U. S. Government securities and a decrease of \$78 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$63 million.

As of Wednesday, July 4, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$348 million higher than a week earlier, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$6 million lower, and member bank borrowings were \$33 million higher.
