WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and

STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ending February 6 increased \$2 million to \$18,920 million. Estimated required reserves decreased \$67 million; and estimated excess reserves increased \$69 million to \$378 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$237 million, compared with \$193 million the week before.

The principal changes supplying average reserves were increases of \$171 million in gold stock and \$113 million in member bank borrowings. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$114 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$99 million in "other" F. R. accounts (net), and decreases of \$15 million in Federal Reserve holdings of U. S. Government securities and \$38 million in Federal Reserve float. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$59 million.

As of Wednesday, February 6, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$65 million lower than a week earlier, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$84 million higher, and member bank borrowings were \$161 million higher.
