WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and

STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ending March 13 decreased \$67 million to \$18,654 million. Estimated required reserves decreased \$44 million; and estimated excess reserves decreased \$23 million to \$405 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$449 million, compared with \$302 million the week before.

The principal changes reducing average reserves were a decrease of \$271 million in Federal Reserve float and an increase of \$44 million in money in circulation. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$124 million in member bank borrowings and \$66 million in Federal Reserve holdings of U. S. Government securities, and a decrease of \$32 million in foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. Total Reserve Bank credit decreased \$80 million.

As of Wednesday, March 13, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$131 million higher than a week earlier, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$37 million higher, and member bank borrowings were \$158 million lower.
