## STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ending March 20 increased \$550 million to \$19,204 million. Estimated required reserves increased \$375 million; and estimated excess reserves increased \$175 million to \$602 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$155 million, compared with \$427 million the week before.

The principal changes supplying average reserves were increases of \$265 million in Federal Reserve float and \$199 million in Federal Reserve holdings of U. S. Government securities, and decreases of \$169 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$20 million in money in circulation. The principal offsetting change was a decrease of \$97 million in member bank borrowings. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$367 million.

As of Wednesday, March 20, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$84 million higher than a week earlier, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$45 million higher, and member bank borrowings were \$254 million higher.
