WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and

STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ending April 3 decreased \$103 million to \$18,868 million. Estimated required reserves increased \$149 million; and estimated excess reserves decreased \$252 million to \$342 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$707 million, compared with \$225 million the week before.

The principal changes reducing average reserves were a decrease of \$90 million in Federal Reserve float, and increases of \$164 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$109 million in "other" deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$86 million in money in circulation. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$230 million in member bank borrowings and \$106 million in U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement, and a decrease of \$40 million in foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$235 million.

As of Wednesday, April 3, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$202 million higher than a week earlier and member bank borrowings were \$504 million higher.
