## STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ending April 17 increased \$19 million to \$19,107 million. Estimated required reserves increased \$18 million; and estimated excess reserves increased \$1 million to \$548 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$671 million, compared with \$658 million the week before.

The principal changes supplying average reserves were increases of \$86 million in Federal Reserve float, \$20 million in Federal Reserve holdings of U.S. Government securities, and \$14 million in member bank borrowings. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$91 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$26 million in money in circulation. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$120 million.

As of Wednesday, April 17, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$129 million higher than a week earlier, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$113 million lower, and member bank borrowings were \$418 million lower.
