STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ending April 24 increased \$94 million to \$19,201 million. Estimated required reserves increased \$74 million; and estimated excess reserves increased \$20 million to \$568 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$354 million, compared with \$671 million the week before.

The principal changes supplying average reserves were an increase of \$517 million in Federal Reserve float and decreases of \$71 million in money in circulation, \$22 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$17 million in Treasury cash holdings. The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$297 million in member bank borrowings and \$45 million in Federal Reserve holdings of U. S. Government securities, and increases of \$154 million in "other" deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$46 million in foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$175 million.

As of Wednesday, April 24, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$69 million lower than a week earlier and member bank borrowings were \$135 million lower.
