WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ending June 19 increased \$314 million to \$19,148 million. Estimated required reserves increased \$217 million; and estimated excess reserves increased \$97 million to \$592 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$497 million, compared with \$556 million the week before.

The principal changes supplying average reserves were increases of \$448 million in Federal Reserve float and \$38 million in member bank borrowings. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$59 million in "other" deposits with Federal Reserve Banks and \$55 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and a decrease of \$42 million in Federal Reserve holdings of U. S. Government securities. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$436 million.

As of Wednesday, June 19, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$19 million lower than a week earlier and member bank borrowings were \$247 million lower.
