WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS

STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ending September 4 decreased \$71 million to \$18,760 million. Estimated required reserves decreased \$65 million; and estimated excess reserves decreased \$6 million to \$455 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$371 million, compared with \$446 million the week before.

The principal changes reducing average reserves were decreases of \$119 million in Federal Reserve float and \$81 million in member bank borrowings, and an increase of \$147 million in money in circulation. The principal offsetting change was an increase of \$291 million in Federal Reserve holdings of U. S. Government securities. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$95 million.

As of Wednesday, September 4, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$111 million higher than a week earlier, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$36 million lower, and member bank borrowings were \$349 million lower.
