WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and

STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ending January 29 decreased \$127 million to \$19,089 million. Estimated required reserves decreased \$113 million; and estimated excess reserves decreased \$14 million to \$511 million. Excess reserves exceeded member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks by \$216 million, compared with \$170 million the week before.

The principal changes reducing average reserves were decreases of \$311 million in Federal Reserve float and \$60 million in member bank borrowings, and an increase of \$48 million in "other" deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting changes were a decrease of \$253 million in money in circulation and an increase of \$57 million in Federal Reserve holdings of U. S. Government securities. Total Reserve Bank credit decreased \$317 million.

As of Wednesday, January 29, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$100 million higher than a week earlier, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$73 million lower, and member bank borrowings were \$134 million lower.
