WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and

STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ending May 14 decreased \$86 million to \$18,190 million. Estimated required reserves decreased \$116 million; and estimated excess reserves increased \$30 million to \$720 million. Excess reserves exceeded member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks by \$597 million, compared with \$572 million the week before.

The principal changes reducing average reserves were decreases of \$82 million in gold stock and \$48 million in Federal Reserve float, and an increase of \$153 million in money in circulation. The principal offsetting changes were an increase of \$132 million in U. S. Government securities bought outright and a decrease of \$63 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$91 million.

As of Wednesday, May 14, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$85 million higher than a week earlier and member bank borrowings were \$9 million lower.
