WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and

STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ending July 9 decreased \$50 million to \$18,809 million. Estimated required reserves decreased \$157 million; and estimated excess reserves increased \$107 million to \$790 million. Excess reserves exceeded member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks by \$647 million, compared with \$586 million the week before.

The principal changes reducing average reserves were increases of \$221 million in money in circulation and \$43 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and a decrease of \$43 million in gold stock. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$132 million in Federal Reserve float, \$46 million in member bank borrowings, and \$34 million in Federal Reserve holdings of U. S. Government securities. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$209 million.

As of Wednesday, July 9, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$18 million lower than a week earlier and member bank borrowings were \$49 million higher.
