## STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ended April 22 increased \$119 million to \$18,817 million. Estimated required reserves increased \$20 million; and estimated excess reserves increased \$99 million to \$612 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$137 million, compared with \$190 million the week before.

The principal changes supplying average reserves were increases of \$314 million in Federal Reserve float and \$46 million in member bank borrowings, and a decrease of \$33 million in money in circulation. The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$211 million in U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement and \$34 million bought outright, and \$31 million in gold stock. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$115 million.

As of Wednesday, April 22, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$25 million lower than a week earlier, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$213 million lower, and member bank borrowings were \$96 million higher.
