WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and

STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ended May 13 decreased \$21 million to \$18,550 million. Estimated required reserves decreased \$113 million; and estimated excess reserves increased \$92 million to \$491 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$218 million, compared with \$276 million the week before.

The principal changes reducing average reserves were a decrease of \$98 million in Federal Reserve float and an increase of \$136 million in money in circulation. The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$202 million in Federal Reserve holdings of U. S. Government securities and \$34 million in member bank borrowings. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$139 million.

As of Wednesday, May 13, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$149 million higher than a week earlier, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$4 million lower, and member bank borrowings were \$210 million lower.
