WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ended July 15 increased \$188 million to \$18,640 million. Estimated required reserves increased \$204 million; and estimated excess reserves decreased \$16 million to \$516 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$486 million, compared with \$495 million the week before.

The principal changes supplying average reserves were an increase of \$194 million in Federal Reserve holdings of U. S. Government securities, and a decrease of \$122 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. The principal offsetting changes were an increase of \$89 million in money in circulation, and decreases of \$26 million in Federal Reserve float and \$25 million in member bank borrowings. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$143 million.

As of Wednesday, July 15, holdings of U.S. Government securities bought outright were \$128 million higher than a week earlier, U.S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$54 million lower, and member bank borrowings were \$256 million lower.
