## STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of member bank reserves for the week ended August 5 decreased \$6 million to \$18,696 million. Estimated required reserves decreased \$55 million; and estimated excess reserves increased \$49 million to \$428 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$606 million, compared with \$511 million the week before.

The principal changes reducing average reserves were a decrease of \$208 million in Federal Reserve float, and increases of \$35 million in money in circulation and \$29 million in "other" F. R. accounts (net). The principal offsetting changes were increases of \$144 million in member bank borrowings, \$58 million in U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement, and \$32 million bought outright, and a decrease of \$56 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. Total Reserve Bank credit increased \$25 million.

As of Wednesday, August 5, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$110 million higher than a week earlier, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$15 million lower, and member bank borrowings were less than one million lower. Holdings of certificates decreased \$8,143 million and notes increased a like amount, reflecting the exchange of certificates maturing August 1 for 4-3/4 per cent issues of notes, \$5,500 million maturing in 1960 and \$2,643 million maturing in 1964.
