WEEKLY AVERAGES OF MEMBER BANK RESERVES, RESERVE BANK CREDIT, AND RELATED ITEMS and STATEMENT OF CONDITION OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

The average of daily figures of total member bank reserves held during the week ended January 13 decreased \$118 million to \$19,028 million, all of which was in member bank reserve balances at the Federal Reserve Banks. Estimated required reserves decreased \$192 million; and estimated excess reserves increased \$74 million to \$583 million. Member bank borrowings at the Federal Reserve Banks exceeded excess reserves by \$328 million, compared with \$504 million the week before.

The principal changes reducing average reserve balances with Federal Reserve Banks were decreases of \$317 million in Federal Reserve float, \$247 million in Federal Reserve holdings of U. S. Government securities, and \$102 million in member bank borrowings. The principal offsetting changes were decreases of \$237 million in currency in circulation, \$221 million in "other" deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, \$63 million in Treasury deposits with Federal Reserve Banks, and \$40 million in foreign deposits with Federal Reserve Banks. Total Reserve Bank credit decreased \$685 million.

As of Wednesday, January 13, holdings of U. S. Government securities bought outright were \$442 million lower than a week earlier, U. S. Government securities held under repurchase agreement were \$31 million higher, and member bank borrowings were \$786 million lower.
