CONDITION OF MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

Aggregate reductions of \$32,000,000 in loans and discounts and of \$9,000,000 in corporate security holdings, as against an increase of \$15,000,000 in the holdings of Government securities, are shown in the Federal Reserve Board's weekly consolidated statement of condition on June 6 of 774 member banks in leading cities. As against an increase of \$10,000,000 in loans on corporate securities, loans on Government securities show a decline of \$5,000,000 and all other, largely commercial, loans and discounts - a decline of \$37,000,000. Changes in the loan and investment accounts of the member banks in New York City comprise a reduction of \$26,000,000 in loans, largely of a commercial character, and an increase of \$9,000,000 in investments, nearly all in Government securities.

All classes of deposits show smaller totals than the week before; Government deposits - by \$45,000,000; other demand deposits (net) by about \$1,000,000 and time deposits - by \$5,000,000. For member banks in New York City reductions of \$12,000,000 in Government deposits, of about \$1,000,000 in demand deposits and of \$7,000,000 in time deposits are noted.

Borrowings of the reporting institutions from the Federal reserve banks show an increase for the week from \$459,000,000 to \$471,000,000, or from 2.8 to 2.9 per cent of their total loans and investments. For member banks in New York City a larger increase, from \$107,000,000 to \$136,000,000, in the borrowings from the local reserve bank, and from 2.1 to 2.6 per cent in the ratio of these borrowings to total loans and investments is noted.

Reserve balances of the reporting banks show an increase of \$20,000,000, and their cash in vault - an increase of \$11,000,000. For member banks in New York City an increase of \$26,000,000 in reserve balances, and a nominal increase in cash is shown.
