CONDITION OF MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

Aggregate reductions of \$127,000,000 in loans, discounts and investments, accompanied with a decrease of \$64,000,000 in deposits and of \$79,000,000 in accommodation at the Federal reserve banks, are shown in the Federal Reserve Board's weekly consolidated statement of condition on July 11 of 773 member banks in leading cities.

Total loans and discounts show a reduction for the week of \$98,000,000. Loans on corporate securities decreased by \$61,000,000, loans on Government securities by \$16,000,000, and all other loans - by \$21,000,000. Investments for the week show a total decrease of \$29,000,000 - \$18,000,000 in U. S. securities and \$11,000,000 in holdings of other bonds, stocks, and securities. Total loans and discounts and investments of the New York City banks show a decrease of \$56,000,000. Loans secured by corporate securities as reported by these banks decreased \$52,000,000 and loans on Government obligations - \$4,000,000, while all other loans increased by \$2,000,000. Holdings of U. S. securities show a decrease of \$2,000,000, and holdings of corporate securities a nominal decrease.

Government deposits of reporting member banks show a reduction of \$48,000,000, while net demand and time deposits show a net reduction of \$16,000,000. For the New York City banks reductions of \$16,000,000 in Government deposits and of \$2,000,000 in net demand and time deposits are shown.

Reserve balances of all reporting institutions show a decrease of \$17,000,000 and those of New York City members - a decrease of \$11,000,000. Cash in vault increased by \$22,000,000, the New York City members reporting an increase of \$3,000,000 under this head.

Borrowings of the reporting institutions from the Federal reserve banks decreased from \$644,000,000 to \$565,000,000, or from 3.9 to 3.4 per cent of their total loans and investments. For member banks in New York City a decrease from \$188,000,000 to \$156,000,000 in borrowings from the reserve bank, or from 3.6 to 3.0 per cent in the ratio of these borrowings to total loans and investments, is noted.
