CONDITION OF MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

Aggregate increases of \$56,000,000 in loans and investments, of \$55,000,000 in net demand deposits, and of \$49,000,000 in accommodation at the Federal reserve banks are shown in the Federal Reserve Board's weekly consolidated statement of condition on September 3 of 747 member banks in leading cities.

Leans on Government obligations increased by \$5,000,000,/leans on other bonds, stocks and securities - by \$80,000,000, while "All other," largely commercial, leans and discounts declined by \$73,000,000. Holdings of United States bonds increased by \$34,000,000, and of Treasury notes and corporate securities - by \$10,000,000 and \$3,000,000, respectively. Holdings of certificates of indebtedness show a decline of \$4,000,000.

Total loans and discounts for reporting member banks in New York City show no change from the preceding week. An increase of \$61,000,000 in loans on corporate securities and of \$4,000,000 in loans on U. S. Securities being offset by a reduction of \$65,000,000 in "All other" loans. Holdings of United States securities increased by \$22,000,000, and holdings of other stocks, bonds, and securities declined by \$9,000,000.

Net demand deposits increased by \$55,000,000. Increases of \$15,000,000, each, are reported for the New York and Cleveland districts, of \$12,000,000 for the St. Louis district, of \$8,000,000 for the Richmond district and of \$7,000,000, each, for the Boston and Minneapolis districts. Decreases of \$12,000,000 and \$11,000,000, respectively, are shown for the Atlanta and Chicago district. Time deposits in*Treased by \$8,000,000 and Government deposits declined by \$10,000,000.

Reserve balances of all reporting institutions increased by \$13,000,000 and cash in vault by \$7,000,000. The New York City banks report increases of \$7,000,000 and \$3,000,000, respectively, in these items.

Borrowings of all reporting members from the Federal reserve banks increased from \$59,000,000 to \$108,000,000, or by \$49,000,000 of which \$44,000,000 represents the increase reported for New York City banks.
