### CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The Federal Reserve Board's condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in 91 leading cities on December 26 shows decreases for the week of \$63,000,000 in total loans and investments and \$25,000,000 in net demand deposits, and an increase of \$6,000,000 in time deposits.

Loans on securities to brokers and dealers in New York City declined \$37,000,000 at reporting member banks in the New York district and \$35,000,000 at all reporting member banks; loans on securities to brokers and dealers outside New York City increased \$3,000,000; and loans an securities to others declined \$11,000,000. Holdings of acceptances and commercial paper declined \$6,000,000 in the New York district and \$9,000,000 at all reporting banks; real estate loans showed little change for the week; and "other loans" declined \$29,000,000 in the New York district, \$6,000,000 in the San Francisco district and \$38,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Holdings of United States Government direct obligations increased \$26,000,000 in the New York district and \$15,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and declined \$5,000,000 in the Cleveland district and \$4,000,000 in the Kansas City district; total holdings of obligations fully guaranteed by the United States Government remained unchanged; and holdings of other securities increased \$20,000,000 in the Chicago district and \$14,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and declined \$6,000,000 in the New York district.

Licensed member banks formerly included in the condition statement of member banks in 101 leading cities, but not now included in the weekly statement, had total loans and investments of \$1,232,000,000 and net demand, time and Government deposits of \$1,374,000,000, compared with \$1,230,000,000 and \$1,369,000,000, respectively, on December 19.
