Condition of Weekly Reporting Member Banks in 101 Leading Cities

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in 101 leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended October 18: Increases of \$18,000,000 in loans to brokers and dealers in securities, \$149,000,000 in reserve balances with Federal Reserve banks, \$72,000,000 in deposits credited to domestic banks, and \$116,000,000 in demand deposits-adjusted.

Commercial, industrial and agricultural loans decreased \$2,000,000. Loans to brokers and dealers in securities increased \$19,000,000 in New York City and

\$13,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$16,000,000 in New York City and \$18,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Holdings of obligations guaranteed by the United States Government decreased \$16,000,000. Holdings of "Other securities" decreased \$26,000,000 in New York City and \$19,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Demand deposits-adjusted increased \$42,000,000 in New York City,

\$23,000,000 in the Cleveland district, \$18,000,000 in the San Francisco district, \$14,000,000 in the Chicago district, and \$116,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Deposits credited to domestic banks increased \$14,000,000 in the Philadelphia district, \$13,000,000 in the Kansas City district, \$10,000,000 each in the Cleveland and Richmond districts and \$72,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Deposits credited to foreign banks increased \$9,000,000 in New York City and \$6,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks amounted to \$1,000,000.on

October 18.
