## Condition of Weekly Reporting Member Banks in 101 Leading Cities

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in 101 leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended November 22: Increases of \$26,000,000 in commercial, industrial and agricultural loans, \$32,000,000 in loans to brokers and dealers in securities, \$92,000,000 in reserve balances with Federal Reserve banks and \$314,000,000 in demand deposits—adjusted, and a decrease of \$189,000,000 in deposits credited to domestic banks.

Commercial, industrial and agricultural loans increased \$28,000,000 in New

York City and \$26,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Holdings of United States Treasury bills increased \$14,000,000 in New York City, \$12,000,000 in the Kansas City district and \$11,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and decreased \$10,000,000 in the Chicago district. Holdings of Treasury notes decreased \$13,000,000. Holdings of "Other securities" increased \$9,000,000 in New York City and \$6,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Demand deposits—adjusted increased \$202,000,000 in New York City, \$26,000,000 in the Chicago district, \$13,000,000 in the Philadelphia district, \$12,000,000 in the San Francisco district, \$11,000,000 in the Cleveland district, \$10,000,000 in the Richmond district, and \$314,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Deposits credited to domestic banks decreased \$42,000,000 in the Chicago

Deposits credited to domestic banks decreased \$42,000,000 in the Chicago district,\$36,000,000 in New York City, \$17,000,000 in the Cleveland district, \$16,000,000 in the Kansas City district, \$15,000,000 in the Philadelphia district, and \$189,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks amounted to \$1,000,000 on

November 22.
