Condition of Weekly Reporting Member Banks in Leading Cities

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in 101 leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended February 3; Decreases of \$334,000,000 in reserve balances with Federal Reserve Banks, \$309,000,000 in demand deposits-adjusted, and \$207,000,000 in deposits credited to domestic banks, and an increase of \$116,000,000 in United States Government deposits.

Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$26,000,000 in the San Francisco District, \$24,000,000 in the Minneapolis District, and \$43,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and declined \$41,000,000 in New York City. Holdings of Treasury certificates of indebtedness declined \$91,000,000 in New York City and \$4,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and increased \$22,000,000 in the Philadelphia District, \$21,000,000 in the Cleveland District, and \$20,000,000 in the New York District outside of New York City. Holdings of United States Government bonds increased \$20,000,000 in New York City, \$11,000,000 each in the Cleveland and Chicago Districts, and \$67,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Demand deposits-adjusted declined in all districts, the principal decreases being \$102,000,000 in the Chicago District, \$57,000,000 in New York City, and \$43,000,000 in the San Francisco District; the total decrease was \$309,000,000. United States Government deposits increased \$60,000,000 in New York City and \$116,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Deposits credited to domestic banks declined \$81,000,000 in New York City, \$51,000,000 in the Chicago District, and \$207,000,000 at all reporting member banks.
