Condition of Weekly Reporting Wember Banks in Leading Cities

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in 101 leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended April 14; An increase of \$477,000,000 in United States Government obligations, a decrease of \$259,000,000 in reserve balances with Federal Reserve Banks, and increases of \$136,000,000 in balances with domestic banks, \$224,000,000 in United States Government deposits, and \$269,000,000 in deposits credited to domestic banks.

Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$260,000,000 in the Chicago District, \$57,000,000 in the Boston District, and \$223,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and declined \$140,000,000 in New York City. Holdings of Treasury certificates of indebtedness increased \$104,000,000 in New York City and \$148,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Holdings of United States Government bonds increased \$83,000,000 in New York City and \$127,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Demand deposits-adjusted increased \$101,000,000 in the Chicago District and \$54,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and declined \$73,000,000 in New York City and \$68,000,000 in the Cleveland District. United States Government deposits increased \$131,000,000 in the Boston District, \$67,000,000 in the Cleveland District, and \$224,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and declined \$116,000,000 in New York City.

Deposits credited to domestic banks increased \$127,000,000 in New York City, \$43,000,000 in the Boston District, and \$269,000,000 at all reporting member banks.
