Condition of Weekly Reporting Member Banks in Leading Cities

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in 101 leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended November 29: Increases of \$585,000,000 in holdings of United States Government obligations and \$1,204,000,000 in United States Government deposits, and a decrease of \$630,000,000 in demand deposits adjusted.

Commercial, industrial, and agricultural loans declined \$26,000,000. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying United States Government obligations increased \$299,000,000 in New York City and \$326,000,000 at all reporting members.

Holdings of Treasury bills increased in most districts, and the total increase at all reporting member banks was \$1\(\pm\)1,000,000; the principal changes were an increase of \$125,000,000 in the Chicago District and a decrease of \$98,000,000 in New York City. Holdings of Treasury certificates of indebtedness and of Treasury notes increased \$110,000,000 and \$93,000,000, respectively. Holdings of United States Government bonds increased in all districts, the principal increase being \$164,000,000 in New York City; the total increase was \$241,000,000.

Demand deposits adjusted declined in mearly all districts, the principal decreases being \$205,000,000 in New York City, \$128,000,000 in the Cleveland District, and \$97,000,000 in the Chicago District; the total decrease was \$630,000,000. United States Government deposits increased in all districts.

Deposits credited to domestic banks increased \$120,000,000 in New York City, \$52,000,000 in the Chicago District, and \$204,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks increased \$101,000,000 during the week, and on November 29 amounted to \$562,000,000.
