For immediate releaseCondition of Weekly Reporting Member Banks in Leading Cities

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in 101 leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended June 27: Increases of \$532,000,000 in loans and investments and \$1,343,000,000 in United States Government deposits, and a decrease of \$809,000,000 in demand deposits adjusted.

Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying United States Government obligations increased \$130,000,000 in New York City and \$112,000,000 at all reporting member banks; other loans for the same purpose increased in all districts and the total increase was \$160,000,000.

Holdings of Treasury certificates of indebtedness increased \$98,000,000 in the Boston District, \$78,000,000 in the Chicago District, and \$106,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and declined \$163,000,000 in New York City. Holdings of United States Government bonds increased in most districts, and the total increase was \$208,000,000. Holdings of Treasury bills and of Treasury notes declined \$57,000,000 and \$44,000,000, respectively.

Demand deposits adjusted declined in most districts, the principal decreases being \$373,000,000 in New York City, \$125,000,000 in the Cleveland District, and \$82,000,000 in the Chicago District. United States Government deposits increased substantially in all districts.

Deposits credited to domestic banks declined \$123,000,000 in New York City, \$42,000,000 in the Chicago District, \$33,000,000 in the San Francisco District, and \$274,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks declined \$126,000,000.
