Condition of Weekly Reporting Member Banks in Leading Cities

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in 101 leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended March 6: Decreases of \$141,000,000 in loans, \$287,000,000 in holdings of United States Government obligations, and \$637,000,000 in United States Government deposits.

Commercial, industrial, and agricultural loans increased \$48,000,000 in New York City and \$76,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying United States Government obligations declined \$175,000,000 and other loans for the same purpose declined \$51,000,000, both largely in New York

City.

Holdings of Treasury bills declined \$82,000,000 in New York City and \$102,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Holdings of Treasury certificates of indebtedness declined \$69,000,000 in the San Francisco District, \$32,000,000 in the Chicago District, \$30,000,000 in the Cleveland District, and \$188,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and increased \$28,000,000 in New York City. Holdings of "other securities" declined \$21,000,000.

Demand deposits adjusted declined \$154,000,000 in New YorkCity,\$106,000,000 in the San Francisco District,and \$215,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Time deposits increased \$29,000,000. United States Government deposits declined in all

districts.

Deposits credited to domestic banks increased in most districts and the total increase was \$76,000,000.

Borrowings increased \$64,000,000 in New York City and \$86,000,000 at all reporting member banks.
