CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in 101 leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended May 22: An increase of \$379,000,000 in demand deposits adjusted, and decreases of \$255,000,000 in United States Government deposits and \$294,000,000 in deposits credited to domestic banks.

Commercial, industrial, and agricultural loans increased \$16,000,000 in the Chicago District and declined \$15,000,000 in New York City; at all reporting member banks there was a net increase of \$6,000,000. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying United States Government obligations declined \$48,000,000 and other loans for the same purpose declined \$31,000,000; these decreases were largely in New York City.

Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$91,000,000 in New York City and \$42,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and declined \$24,000,000 in the Richmond District. Holdings of Treasury certificates of indebtedness increased \$86,000,000 in New York City, \$36,000,000 in the Chicago District, and \$84,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Holdings of Treasury notes declined \$59,000,000 in New York City, \$33,000,000 in the Chicago District, and a total of \$74,000,000. Holdings of United States Government bonds increased \$29,000,000 in New York City, \$16,000,000 in the San Francisco District, and \$42,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Demand deposits adjusted increased \$264,000,000 in New York City, \$52,000,000 in the Cleveland District, and \$379,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Both United States Government deposits and deposits credited to domestic banks declined in all districts.

Borrowings of reporting member banks increased \$45,000,000.
