CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in 101 leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended July 24: An increase of \$164,000,000 in commercial, industrial, and agricultural loans; decreases of \$341,000,000 in holdings of Treasury bills, \$288,000,000 in United States Government deposits, and \$352,000,000 in deposits credited to domestic banks; and an increase of \$180,000,000 in demand deposits adjusted.

Commercial, industrial, and agricultural loans increased \$81,000,000 in New York City, \$19,000,000 each in the Chicago and San Francisco districts, and \$164,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying United States Government obligations declined \$199,000,000 and other loans for the same purpose declined \$38,000,000, both largely in New York City. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying other securities increased in all districts and the total increase at all reporting member banks was \$82,000,000.

Holdings of Treasury bills declined \$129,000,000 in New York City, \$99,000,000 in the Chicago District, \$52,000,000 in the San Francisco District, and \$341,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Demand deposits adjusted increased \$128,000,000 in New York City and \$180,000,000 at all reporting member banks. United States Government deposits declined in all districts. Deposits credited to domestic banks declined in nearly all districts and the total decrease at all reporting member banks was \$352,000,000; the principal decrease was \$153,000,000 in New York City.
