CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in 101 leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended April 16: A decrease of \$161,000,000 in loans, and increases of \$518,000,000 in holdings of United States Government securities and \$546,000,000 in demand deposits adjusted.

Commercial, industrial, and agricultural loans declined \$59,000,000 in New York City and \$86,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and increased \$12,000,000 in the City of Chicago.

Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$302,000,000 in New York City, \$62,000,000 in the Chicago District, \$31,000,000 in the Cleveland District, and \$372,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Holdings of Treasury certificates of indebtedness increased \$61,000,000 in the Chicago District and \$73,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Holdings of Treasury notes declined \$32,000,000. Holdings of United States Government bonds increased \$78,000,000 in New York City, \$11,000,000 each in the Cleveland and Chicago Districts, and \$105,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and declined \$13,000,000 in the Boston District.

Demand deposits adjusted increased \$198,000,000 in the Chicago District, \$118,000,000 in New York City, \$76,000,000 in the Cleveland District, \$52,000,000 in the San Francisco District, \$34,000,000 in the Kansas City District, \$28,000,000 in the Atlanta District, and \$546,000,000 at all reporting member banks. United States Government deposits and demand deposits credited to domestic banks increased \$22,000,000 and \$42,000,000, respectively.

Borrowings declined \$49,000,000 in New York City, \$34,000,000 in the New York District outside of New York City, \$21,000,000 in the Cleveland District, and \$123,000,000 at all reporting member banks.
