CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended December 3: Decreases of \$502,000,000 in holdings of Treasury certificates of indebtedness and \$439,000,000 in holdings of United States Government bonds, and an increase of \$850,000,000 in holdings of Treasury notes, partially reflecting the exchange of maturing certificates and bonds for a new note issue; an increase of \$265,000,000 in demand deposits adjusted and a decrease of \$307,000,000 in United States Government deposits.

Commercial, industrial, and agricultural loans increased \$40,000,000 in New York City, \$18,000,000 in the Chicago District, and \$91,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Holdings of Treasury bills decreased \$73,000,000. Substantial increases in holdings of Treasury notes and decreases in holdings of Treasury certificates of indebtedness and of United States Government bonds occurred in nearly all districts.

Demand deposits adjusted increased \$244,000,000 in New York City, \$72,000,000 in the San Francisco District, and \$46,000,000 in the Cleveland District, and decreased \$99,000,000 in the Kansas City District. United States Government deposits decreased in all districts. Demand deposits credited to domestic banks increased \$56,000,000 in the Chicago District, \$40,000,000 in New York City, and \$176,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Borrowings decreased \$112,000,000 in New York City, \$26,000,000 in the Richmond District, and \$134,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and increased \$22,000,000 in the Kansas City District.
