CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended December 8: Increases of \$163,000,000 in loans to brokers and dealers and \$243,000,000 in demand deposits adjusted, and a decrease of \$364,000,000 in U. S. Government deposits.

Commercial, industrial, and agricultural loans decreased \$63,000,000 in New York City and \$68,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and increased \$26,000,000 in the San Francisco District. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying United States Government securities increased \$133,000,000 in New York City and \$135,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying other securities increased \$48,000,000 in New York City and \$28,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and decreased \$24,000,000 in Chicago.

Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$47,000,000 in the Kansas City District and \$93,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and decreased \$34,000,000 in the Philadelphia District. Holdings of United States Government bonds increased \$32,000,000.

Demand deposits adjusted increased \$67,000,000 in the Kansas City District, \$41,000,000 in New York City, and \$39,000,000 in the San Francisco District. Time deposits increased \$36,000,000 in Chicago and \$48,000,000 at all reporting member banks. United States Government deposits decreased in all districts. Demand deposits credited to domestic banks decreased \$128,000,000 in New York City and \$3,000,000 at all reporting member banks, and increased \$38,000,000 in the St. Louis District and \$37,000,000 in the Atlanta District.

Borrowings increased \$149,000,000 in New York City and \$112,000,000 at all reporting member banks.
