H.4.2 (For Immediate Release) June 15, 1949 CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended June 8: A decrease of \$715,000,000 in loans, an increase of \$312,000,000 in holdings of United States Government securities, and decreases of \$214,000,000 in United States Government deposits and \$167,000,000 in borrowings.

Commercial, industrial, and agricultural loans decreased \$17,000,000 in New York City, \$11,000,000 in the San Francisco District, and a total of \$61,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying United States Government securities decreased \$477,000,000, largely in New York City. Real estate loans increased \$11,000,000, and loans to banks decreased \$155,000,000.

Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$60,000,000. Holdings of Treasury certificates of indebtedness increased \$121,000,000 in New York City and a total of \$160,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Holdings of United States Government bonds increased \$39,000,000 in New York City, \$31,000,000 in the San Francisco District, and a total of \$106,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Demand deposits adjusted decreased \$60,000,000 in the Chicago District and increased \$24,000,000 in the Philadelphia District; the net decrease at all reporting member banks was \$69,000,000. United States Government deposits decreased in all districts. Demand deposits credited to domestic banks increased \$139,000,000.

Borrowings decreased \$175,000,000 in New York City and \$23,000,000 in Chicago, and increased \$30,000,000 in the New York District outside of New York City.
