CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended July 6: A decrease of \$715,000,000 in loans; increases of \$557,000,000 in holdings of United States Government securities and \$964,000,000 in demand deposits credited to domestic banks; and decreases of \$249,000,000 in demand deposits adjusted, \$210,000,000 in United States Government deposits, and \$166,000,000 in borrowings.

Commercial, industrial, and agricultural loans decreased in most of the districts, and a total of \$172,000,000 at all reporting member banks; the principal decreases were \$56,000,000 in New York City, \$37,000,000 in the San Francisco District, \$22,000,000 in the Cleveland District, and \$21,000,000 in Chicago. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying United States Government and othe securities decreased \$419,000,000, largely in New York City.

Holdings of Treasury bills increased in all but one district, and a total of \$321,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Holdings of Treasury certificates of indebtedness increased \$51,000,000 in the San Francisco District and a total of \$147,000,000 at all reporting member banks. Holdings of United States Government bonds increased \$79,000,000. Holdings of "other securities" increased \$66,000,000 in New York City and a total of \$104,000,000 at all reporting member banks.

Demand deposits adjusted decreased \$162,000,000 in New York City and \$55,000,000 in the Cleveland District, and increased \$60,000,000 in the San Francisco District. Demand deposits credited to domestic banks increased substantially in all districts.

Borrowings decreased \$175,000,000 in New York City.
