The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended March 27: Decreases of \$284 million in loans adjusted, \$826 million in holdings of U. S. Government securities, \$399 million in reserve balances with Federal Reserve Banks, \$232 million

ities, \$399 million in reserve balances with Federal Reserve Banks, \$232 million in demand deposits adjusted, \$759 million in U. S. Government deposits, and \$138 million in demand deposits credited to domestic banks.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased \$137 million at all reporting member banks; the principal changes were decreases of \$119 million in New York City and \$18 million in the Dallas District, and an increase of \$19 million in the San Francisco District. Changes according to industry appear in another press release. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U. S. Government and other securities decreased \$152 million.

Holdings of Treasury bills decreased \$446 million and holdings of Treasury certificates of indebtedness decreased \$346 million, reflecting retirement of tax anticipation issues on March 22. Holdings of U. S. Government bonds and of "other" securities decreased \$54 million and \$33 million, respectively.

Demand deposits adjusted decreased \$113 million in New York City, \$81 million in the Boston District, and \$79 million in the Cleveland District, but they increased \$87 million in the Chicago District. Time deposits increased \$47 million.

Borrowings from Federal Reserve Banks decreased \$330 million and borrowings from others increased \$56 million. Loans to banks increased \$53 million.
