CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended December 2: Increases of \$451 million in loans adjusted, \$932 million in holdings of U. S. Government securities, \$1,084 million in U. S. Government demand deposits, \$568 million in demand deposits credited to domestic banks, and \$102 million in demand deposits credited to foreign banks, and a decrease of \$243 million in demand deposits adjusted.

Commercial and industrial loans increased \$114 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U. S. Government securities increased \$111 million and loans to nonbank financial institutions increased \$145 million. "Other"

loans increased \$93 million.

Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$1,007 million reflecting purchases of the new 320-day issue. Holdings of the combined total of Treasury notes and U. S. Government bonds decreased \$89 million.
