CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended December 16: Increases of \$1,506 million in loans adjusted, \$1,609 million in demand deposits adjusted, and \$587 million in U. S. Government demand deposits, and a decrease of \$727 million in borrowings from other than Federal Reserve Banks.

Commercial and industrial loans increased \$389 million at all reporting member banks and loans to nonbank financial institutions increased \$407 million, which reflected quarterly tax date needs. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U. S. Government and other securities increased \$607 million.

Holdings of U. S. Government securities decreased \$212 million. Demand deposits credited to domestic banks increased \$512 million.
