

CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended December 30: Increases of \$476 million in loans adjusted and \$783 million in demand deposits adjusted, and a decrease of \$429 million in U. S. Government demand deposits.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased in eight districts and a net of \$5 million at all reporting member banks. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U. S. Government and other securities increased \$202 million and loans to nonbank financial institutions increased \$170 million. "Other" loans increased \$56 million.

Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$83 million. The combined total of Treasury notes and U. S. Government bonds decreased \$89 million.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks from Federal Reserve Banks decreased \$50 million and borrowings from others decreased \$283 million. Loans to domestic commercial banks decreased \$307 million.
