CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended February 10: Decreases of \$118 million in loans adjusted, \$327 million in holdings of U. S. Government securities, and \$719 million in U. S. Government demand deposits.

Commercial and industrial loans increased in most districts and a total of \$106 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Government and other securities decreased \$134 million, and loans to nonbank financial institutions decreased \$83 million.

Holdings of Treasury bills decreased \$248 million and the combined total of Treasury notes and U. S. Government bonds decreased \$64 million.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks from Federal Reserve Banks decreased \$203 million and borrowings from others increased \$509 million. Loans to domestic commercial banks increased \$136 million.
