## CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended May 4: Increases of \$217 million in loans adjusted, \$314 million in reserve balances with Federal Reserve Banks, \$1,353 million in U. S. Government demand deposits, and \$524 million in demand deposits credited to domestic banks, and a decrease of \$1,700 million in demand deposits adjusted.

Commercial and industrial loans increased in most districts and a total of \$73 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions increased \$187 million but loans to other nonbank financial institutions decreased \$36 million.

Holdings of Treasury bills decreased \$122 million and holdings of "other" securities decreased \$167 million.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks from Federal Reserve Banks decreased \$17 million and borrowings from others decreased \$2 million. Loans to domestic commercial banks decreased \$23 million.
