## CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended July 6: Increases of \$402 million in reserve balances with Federal Reserve Banks, \$812 million in demand deposits credited to domestic banks, and \$869 million in borrowings, and decreases of \$1,003 million in demand deposits adjusted and \$407 million in U. S. Government demand deposits.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased in seven districts and a total of \$196 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U. S. Government and other securities increased \$40 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions increased \$112 million.

Holdings of Treasury bills decreased \$52 million and holdings of the combined total of Treasury notes and U. S. Government bonds decreased \$58 million.
