CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended July 13: Increases of \$2,187 million in holdings of U. S. Government securities, \$794 million in demand deposits adjusted, and \$1,379 million in U. S. Government demand deposits.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased in nine districts and a total of \$76 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U. S. Government securities increased \$263 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions decreased \$109 million. "Other" loans decreased \$41 million.

Holdings of Treasury bills increased in all districts and a total of \$2,217 million, largely reflecting purchases of the new issue of tax anticipation bills.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks from Federal Reserve Banks decreased \$81 million and borrowings from others decreased \$124 million. Loans to domestic com-
