CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended November 2: An increase of \$687 million in loans adjusted; decreases of \$261 million in holdings of U. S. Government securities and \$446 million in demand deposits adjusted; and increases of \$340 million in U. S. Government demand deposits and \$874 million in demand deposits credited to domestic banks.

Commercial and industrial loans increased \$215 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U. S. Government and other securities increased \$303 million. Loans to nonbank financial institutions increased \$117 million.

Holdings of Treasury bills decreased \$369 million, and the combined total of

Treasury notes and U. S. Government bonds increased by \$93 million.

Demand deposits credited to foreign banks decreased \$111 million. of individuals, partnerships, and corporations increased \$66 million.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks from Federal Reserve Banks decreased \$556 million and borrowings from others increased \$490 million. Loans to domestic commercial banks increased \$472 million.
