H.4.2 CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended November 28: A decrease of \$176 million in loans adjusted, an increase of \$1,021 million in demand deposits adjusted, and a decrease of \$680 million in U. S. Government demand deposits.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased in ten districts and a net of \$118 million; during the comparable week a year ago, these loans increased \$85 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U. S. Government securities decreased \$39 million. Loans to sales and personal financing institutions decreased \$67 million and loans to "other" nonbank financial institutions decreased \$13 million, as compared with an increase of \$50 million and a decrease of \$6 million, respectively, during the similar week in 1961. Real estate loans increased \$23 million. "Other" loans decreased \$4 million.

Holdings of Treasury bills by weekly reporting member banks increased \$127 million, Treasury certificates increased \$3 million, and the combined total of Treasury notes and U. S. Government bonds decreased \$40 million. "Other" securities increased \$99 million.

Demand deposits adjusted increased in all but two districts and included increases of \$375 million in the Chicago District, \$193 million in New York City, \$162 million in the Cleveland District, \$133 million in the Philadelphia District, \$83 million in the Dallas District, and \$80 million in the San Francisco District. Savings deposits increased \$41 million and "other" time deposits of individuals, partnerships, and corporations increased \$114 million.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks from Federal Reserve Banks decreased \$50 million and borrowings from others decreased \$390 million. Loans to domestic commercial banks decreased \$204 million.
