CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended May 22: Decreases of \$208 million in loans adjusted and \$256 million in holdings of U. S. Government securities; increases of \$288 million in holdings of "other" securities, \$239 million in demand deposits adjusted, and \$277 million in U. S. Government demand deposits; a decrease of \$1,188 million in demand deposits credited to domestic commercial banks; and an increase of \$174 million in time and savings deposits.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased in all but one district and a net of \$166 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans decreased \$145 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U. S. Government securities decreased \$113 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities increased \$97 million. Loans to sales and personal financing institutions decreased \$148 million as compared with a decrease of \$72 million during the similar week in 1962. Real estate loans increased \$81 million.

Holdings of Treasury bills by weekly reporting member banks decreased \$122 million, Treasury certificates increased \$25 million, and the combined total of Treasury notes and U. S. Government bonds decreased \$159 million.

Demand deposits adjusted increased \$258 million in New York City, \$131 million in the Chicago District, and \$66 million in the Dallas District, but they decreased \$186 million in the San Francisco District. Savings deposits increased \$62 million and "other" time deposits of individuals, partnerships, and corporations increased \$97 million.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks from Federal Reserve Banks increased \$167 million but borrowings from others decreased \$188 million. Loans to domestic commercial banks decreased \$184 million.
