H.4.2 CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended October 16: Increases of \$618 million in loans adjusted, \$997 million in demand deposits adjusted, and \$555 million in demand deposits credited to domestic commercial banks; and a decrease of \$1,068 million in U. S. Government demand deposits.

Commercial and industrial loans increased in ten districts and a net of \$161 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans increased \$136 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U. S. Government securities increased \$248 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities increased \$68 million. Loans to sales and personal financing institutions decreased \$91 million and loans to "other" nonbank financial institutions increased \$24 million, as compared with a decrease of \$7 million and an increase of \$13 million, respectively, during the similar week in 1962. Real estate loans increased \$85 million. "Other" loans increased \$83 million.

Holdings of Treasury bills by weekly reporting member banks increased \$22 million, Treasury certificates decreased \$15 million, and the combined total of Treasury notes and U. S. Government bonds decreased \$58 million. "Other" securities increased \$109 million.

Demand deposits adjusted increased in all but one district and included increases of \$362 million in New York City, \$159 million in the San Francisco

District, \$153 million in the Chicago District, \$93 million in the Boston District and \$62 million in the Cleveland District. Savings deposits increased \$40 million and "other" time deposits of individuals, partnerships, and corporations increased \$54 million.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks from Federal Reserve Banks increased \$178 million but borrowings from others decreased \$388 million. Loans to domestic commercial banks decreased \$509 million.
