## H.4.2 CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended March 4: Increases of \$469 million in holdings of U. S. Government securities and \$186 million in holdings of "other" securities, a decrease of \$272 million in demand deposits adjusted, and an increase of \$1,157 million in demand deposits credited to domestic commercial banks.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$3 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans increased \$75 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U. S. Government securities decreased \$108 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities increased \$87 million. Loans to sales and personal financing institutions increased \$49 million and loans to "other" nonbank financial institutions decreased \$27 million, as compared with decreases of \$107 million and \$19 million, respectively, during the similar week in 1963. Real estate loans increased \$4 million. "Other" loans increased \$21 million.

Holdings of Treasury bills by weekly reporting member banks increased \$582 million, and the combined total of Treasury notes and U. S. Government bonds decreased \$114 million.

Demand deposits adjusted decreased in all but four districts and included decreases of \$106 million in the City of Chicago, \$99 million in the Kansas City District, and \$63 million in the Dallas District. Savings deposits increased \$61 million and "other" time deposits of individuals, partnerships, and corporations increased \$90 million.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks from Federal Reserve Banks decreased \$516 million and borrowings from others decreased \$192 million. Loans to domestic commercial banks decreased \$129 million.
