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CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended September 1: increases of \$1,122 million in loans adjusted, \$64 million in holdings of U. S. Government securities, a decrease of \$843 million in reserves with Federal Reserve Banks, an increase of \$602 million in demand deposits adjusted, a decrease of \$1,078 million in U. S. Government demand deposits, and an increase of \$1,199 million in demand deposits credited to domestic commercial banks.

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$31 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans increased \$189 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U. S. Government securities increased \$347 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities increased \$107 million. Loans to sales and personal financing institutions increased \$435 million and loans to "other" nonbank financial institutions increased \$72 million, as compared with increases of \$55 million and \$42 million, respectively, during the similar week in 1964. Real estate loans increased \$53 million. "Other" loans increased \$83 million.

Holdings of Treasury bills by weekly reporting member banks increased \$223 million and the combined total of Treasury notes and U. S. Government bonds decreased \$159 million. "Other" securities increased \$11 million.

Demand deposits adjusted increased in ten districts including increases of \$138 million in the San Francisco District, \$132 million in New York City, \$88 million in the Boston District, and \$65 million in the Philadelphia District. Savings deposits increased \$40 million and "other" time deposits of individuals, partnerships, and corporations increased \$67 million.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks from Federal Reserve Banks decreased \$332 million and borrowings from others decreased \$225 million. Loans to domestic commercial banks decreased \$234 million.
